Key Roles and Responsibilities

- Coordination of staffing, material, and equipment needs of multiple projects.
- Perform take-offs in order to prepare work orders and load lists to organize for future field activities.
- Perform notification of required utility locates.
- Review completed work orders and time sheets for accuracy and proper documentation of quantities and pay activities.
- Coordinate with customers and owners' representatives to problem-solve and discuss discrepancies, change order disputes, and schedule difficulties in order to reach a resolution.
- Assist the Superintendents with field operations as needed.
- Attend pre-construction and progress meetings of multiple projects, as well as other specific meetings throughout the duration of the project.
- Comprehend INDOT Specifications, especially sections 100, 801, 802, and 808. Apply knowledge in order to perform activities correctly and accurately in the most efficient way possible.
- Effectively communicate with co-workers, supervisors, customers (prime contractors), and owner's representatives through clear and concise electronic, written, and verbal methods.
- Understand and adhere to Company policies, procedures, rules and regulations.

- Excellent logistics ability to identify and solve problems
- Excellent computer skills (Microsoft Office, Adobe)
